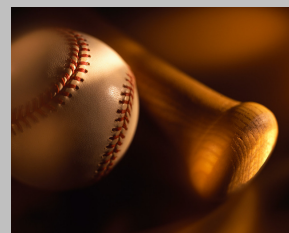
Individual Lessons Update
